New projects in central Mumbai

With 7,500 upcoming housing units and four million square feet of commercial space under construction, Kurla, Ghatkopar and Vidyavihar are set to change the face of central Mumbai

Complex (BKC) is a complex that is buzzing with corporate, administrative and consulate offices as well as international schools and five star hotels. Approximately 4 lakh people work in this commer-

A major effect of the popularity of BKC is that sur-Vidyavihar and Ghatkopar have risen in status as well. These areas, which were dominated by chawls, slums and small industrial units in the 90s, are seeing an influx projects and amenities such as malls and parks.

THE BKC BUZZ

Affordability and proximity to BKC is a definite boost to the market here, according to Aniruddh Wahal, director of Occupier Services West, DTZ India "Approximately 5,000 residential units are under development in 40 projects while another 2,500 have been proposed. These comprise eight percent of the total residential supply of 90,000 units is expected in four million so ft of commercial space is under development in this belt." This is in stark contrast to the rest of the city.

Even among the three areas. Kurls is developing most rapidly and is flooded with commercial and residential projects by Equinox. Phoenix, HDIL and Kohinoor. Its proximity to the airport Highway on one side and the Eastern Express Highway and LBS Marg on the other is an added advantage. The area is also well connected to south Mumbai, Thane and Navi Mumbai by road and rail.

Upcoming projects like the metro rail connecting Ghatkopar-Vidyavihar to the western suburbs and the Santacruz-Chembur Link Road promise to serve more luxuries for the residents of the area.
